*Have you ever felt like you were just going through the motions with something? - Why do you think “lukewarm” is not appealing to God?
- How does the statement, “I am rich...I do not need a thing” indicate a sense of self-sufficiency?
- How does self-sufficiency contrast with an accurate view of our need for relationship with God?
- In what ways does self-sufficiency not serve us well in relationship with God?
- What does it look like to be diligent and turn from indifference?
- What does it mean to you personally that Jesus is standing at the door and knocking?
- What things do you consider when deciding whether to open the door to Jesus?
- What does Jesus’ promise to come in and have a meal as friends mean to you personally?
- What is something you can do intentionally every day that requires you to trust God?
