

DIGGING DEEPER PART 1: BEYOND COMPREHENSION SUNDAY, JUNE 7, 2020

There are things we don't know simply because they are beyond our comprehension. But it's possible to know what we don't know because there are ways God lets us know.

READ 1 CORINTHIANS 2:16

- Have there been times that God has revealed the meaning of the passage which earlier you had difficulty understanding?
- In Luke 10:21 Jesus is said to have *revealed spiritual truths to little children* that others could not understand. Are you someone who is humble, dependent, and teachable?
- Do you understand the limitations of non-believers to understand your faith and confession? What implications does that place on your sharing your faith with them?
- *Teach me the patience of unanswered prayer* are words taken from a hymn of the church. What does it mean to you? What does it tell you about God's timing?
- Has the Holy Spirit ever brought to your mind a verse of Scripture at a time when you desperately needed it?
- What steps do you take to understand the will of God in a personal matter of significant consequence? (Read II Kings 19.14)
- What have you learned about yourself in answering the above questions.
