

DIGGING DEEPER PART 3: GETTING THERE SUNDAY, JUNE 28, 2020

Sometimes we can become so focused on the destination that we miss the journey of getting where we want to go. When it comes to becoming who God desires us to be, there is certainly a destination in mind.

- I Peter 4.1-2 Verse 2 “*he who has suffered in his body is done with sin.*” is somewhat difficult to interpret. Ask the Lord to reveal the meaning of the verse to you as you study it carefully.
- Psalms 135.5-12 Apply what you have learned about the sovereignty of God to these verses.
- Romans 9.17 and Exodus 14.4 - II Chronicles 36.22 and Isaiah 44.28 We all know the stories of Pharaoh and Cyrus. Are you able to interpret to someone else what these verses say of them?
- II Peter 3.8-13 Where do you see the perfect will of God expressed in this paragraph?
- James 4.13-17 How does the phrase “*If it is the Lord’s will*” fit into your theology of prayer? e.g. Is it God’s will that everyone who is sick be healed? If not, how should we pray?
- Acts 16.6-10 The will of God obviously directed the steps of the early apostles. In what ways can you recall did the Lord’s preventive will keep you from doing something you had planned or kept something from happening to you which might have happened had He not intervened?
- Luke 22.39-46 The will of the Father played an important role in the life of the Son. The Gethsemane story is awesome to contemplate. Do you believe believers today can experience their own Gethsemane? Have you?
