- What is the difference between constructive pride and destructive pride?
- How would you describe a humble person? In what ways does a humble approach impact relationship with others?
- Why is it so challenging to consider the interests of others as well as our own?
- Why might Jesus have not considered equality with God something to be grasped or used to his own advantage (especially considering he is God)?
- What was the motivation for Jesus to give up his position and privilege for humankind?
- What does Jesus taking on the very nature of a servant look like and mean to you personally?
- What did Jesus’ death on the cross accomplish in relationship to/with God?
- In what ways did humility lead to Jesus being exalted?
- What next step will you take to have the same mindset as Jesus?
