READ DEUTERONOMY 28:1-14

- What covenant did God establish with Moses?
- What are ways the covenant God established with Moses connect to your relationship with God?
- How has God fulfilled the covenant made with Moses?

READ 2 SAMUEL 7:8-16

- What covenant did God establish with David?
- What are ways the covenant God established with David connect to your relationship with God?
- How has God fulfilled the covenant made with David?

READ MATTHEW 1:1 & HEBREWS 9:14-15

- What do you think is the significance of Jesus being a descendant of David and Abraham?
- What do you think it means that Jesus is the mediator of a new covenant?
- What does the new covenant offer beyond the previous covenants?
- What are ways the new covenant connects to your relationship with God?

- Do you believe God is a covenant-keeping God? Why or why not?
- What next step will you take to embrace covenant relationship with God and extend covenant relationship to others?
