- Why would the world rejoice at the event Jesus is speaking about?

- How will this event turn grief into wonderful joy?
- How do you react to Jesus saying life will be full of MANY trials and sorrows?
- If Jesus said to expect MANY trials and sorrows, why do you think so many people fail to expect them?
- What do you think it means to have peace IN Jesus?
- How do you feel about the trials and sorrows of this world eventually being a thing of the past?
- What does it mean that Jesus overcame the world? How did he do it?
- What next step will you take to turn “now great sorrow” into “wonderful joy”?
